- What is your plan for the next 3 months?

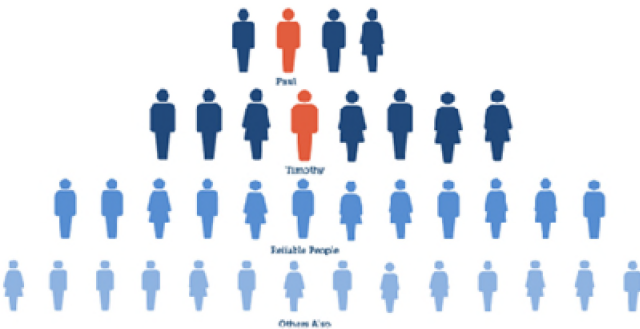
How can you multiply the first 4 habits (Pray, Engage, Find, Discover) in the months ahead?
